CODE OF CONDUCT

- Its is obligation on the part of students to obey the rules of the college and to respect and uphold the tradition of the college.
- Students should properly dress and come to college.
 - ✓ Boys, to wear Pants and Shirts only allowed.
 - ✓ Girls, to wear Half Sarees, Sarees, Chudithar with Dupatta are allowed.
- Students should attend the classes regularly and punctually. They should also come to the functions and other activities of the college well in time and neatly dressed.
- Every student must be present for the morning prayer in the class.
- Student should greet the members of the staff on meeting then for the first time.
- When a staff member enters the classroom, the students should keep standing till they are asked to be seated. Similarly, they should also stand up and say thanks to the staff member when he/she leaves the class.
- During class hours either the Principal or any other staff member or visitor enters the classroom, the students should give respect to them by standing up.
- Students should not leave the classroom without getting Permission from the concerned Lecturer or the Principal.
- Students are forbidden to enter any laboratory without any permission of the staff incharge.

- Cell phones are not permitted inside the college campus.
- Students shall spend their free hours in the Reading Room in the Library.
- Loitering and making noise in the college campus are strictly forbidden.
- Every student should handle college property with care and do everything in his/his power to preserve the cleanliness to the buildings, furniture and college campus.
- Writing or scribbling on the walls, floors or any part of the college buildings and on the furniture is strictly prohibited.
- No student should take part in any activity or movement which the college authorities think undesirable for students.
- Students are forbidden to attend or to organize any meeting in the college or outside the college campus or collect money for any purpose without the permission of the Principal.
- Students should be respectful to seniors and superiors, polite and courteous to all, ready to oblige and to show themselves as lovers of good order and decorum.
- Any student found to be indifferent or careless in his/her work or whose conduct is considered to be detrimental to the interest of the college is liable to punishment which may lead to severe disciplinary action.
- Smoking within the college premises, use of drugs and alcoholic beverages of all kinds are strictly forbidden.
- No political or communal organisation of students may be formed within the college.
- Tours or picnics by students without the permission of the college is serious offence.
- As per the provision of the Tamil Nadu Educational Rules, the Principal shall have full powers to inflict punishment, such as imposition of fines, loss of attendance, loss of term certificate, suspension and expulsion.
